# THANKS FOR HELPING UNI IN 2016!

- ▶ Thanks to your contributions, the UHEF was busy in 2016, not just in supporting today's Uni, but also important projects that keep Uni's legacy alive and tie today's students and alumni closer. Some of the highlights:
  - The UHEF financed the renovation of the computer systems for the Mednick College Center at Uni, a facility originally made possible by a donation from *Steve Kirsch* '74 and his wife Michelle.
  - A new sound system was underwritten as part of the renovation of the Stivelman Theater for performing arts presentations and student assemblies.
  - The UHEF underwrote the cost of tournament entry fees to help re-launch the Speech and Debate Club on campus after decades of inactivity.
  - Three UHEF scholarship awards were made at the end of the 2015-16 school year. The recipients:

- Revival of the All-Classes Picnic and Car Show on May 15, and announcement of the first University High School Film Festival, scheduled for April 2017.
- Naming of the new athletic facilities for Uni icons *Dick Kampmann* (Uni cross country and track coach, 1960-85), *Mel Patton* '43 (double Olympic gold medalist in 1948) and *Angus Cavanaugh* (first Uni principal, 1924-35) as KAMPMANN STADIUM, PATTON TRACK and CAVANAUGH FIELD.
- Creation of a free-to-view archive of Uni's Chieftain yearbooks from 1924 through 1994, with completion of the archive through 2000 early in 2017.
- Creation of an adult version of the old "Warrior Athletic Card" (now "Wildcat Activity Card") as the Warriors & Wildcats Activity Card for alumni.
- Launch of a new program, in coordination with Uni, to allow alumni and friends of the school to purchase books for the library, with direct shipment to the school itself.
- Continuing support for class reunion committees, providing names and mailing addresses from the UHEF's database of more than 14,000 alumni.

# SIX ALUMS HAVE BOUGHT BOOKS FOR THE UNI LIBRARY ~ WILL YOU HELP?

• One of the more innovative ideas of 2016 was the partnership between the UHEF and the Uni Library to update the school's collection. Since November, six alumni have stepped forward to contribute 27 new books, namely

Jeff Deckman '76 • Ivan Finkle S '50 • Richard E. Leonard W '48 Ruth Roberts S '64 • Ruth Albert Wasser (no grad year given)

That's five and one asked to remain anonymous. The strength of this program is that many of the books are student requests, based on their class assignments and interests. Uni librarian *Tascha Folsoi* '86 created the program, using Amazon.com's "Wish List" to post desired titles. Anyone can go to the list (*here*), purchase one or more books – four of the six supporters so far bought multiple books – and they will be sent to Uni directly within two business days.

The "University Senior High Library" Wish List enjoys Amazon Prime status thanks to Folsoi, so that you (as the purchaser) <u>do not</u> have to be an Amazon Prime member to buy any of the books!

Folsoi asks for help if you buy a book: "I think it would be better if we also asked people to email me their name and grad year along with items purchased, so I can email them back with the tax I.D. number and also remove the items from the list." # INAUGURAL UNI FILM FESTIVAL SLATED FOR APRIL 28-29

Los Angeles is the long-time home of the U.S. entertainment industry and in the heyday of the Hollywood studios, Uni's was its favored high school, with alums such as *Jeff Bridges*, *Ryan O'Neal, Elizabeth Taylor* and *Norma Baker*, later known as Marilyn Monroe.

So Uni and the UHEF will partner this spring for the first UNIVERSITY HIGH SCHOOL FILM FESTIVAL, over two nights in late April, at the renovated Stivelman Theater:

• Friday Apr. 28 4:00 p.m. Student Film Festival

• Saturday Apr. 29 6:00 p.m. Alumni reception and film screening

Friday's program will feature student films from Uni and other high schools, while the Saturday event will bring alumni together for a reception, selected reunions, a silent auction

and the screening of a film with special meaning in Uni's history.

The Film Festival will replace the springtime All-Classes Picnic and Car Show, which was revived in May 2016, but – outside of the enthusiastic car owners – did not draw a significant crowd back to campus.

## **UNI ONLINE YEARBOOK PROJECT NEARING COMPLETION**

After more than a year of planning and production efforts, a total of 66 school yearbooks are now online and viewable, free of charge, at www.uhef.org/unihighyearbooks.

This is a remarkable legacy achievement, created in conjunction with Uni's librarian, Tascha Folsoi '86. Nearly all of the yearbooks from 1924 – for what was them known as Wilson Jr. High School – through 1994 have been scanned, matched and uploaded. By decade:

- 1924-29: Missing 1928, but a copy has been offered by **Donald Grandfield** '59, which will be scanned and added as soon as possible.
- 1930-39: Missing 1934, for which a copy has been found and is now being scanned.
- Complete, although yearbooks were not produced for 1943 and 1944 due to paper rationing 1940-49: during World War II. A special scrapbook of Uni faculty and staff who served in the military is included as a special memory of that time.
- 1950-59: Complete! Complete! 1960-69:
- 1970-79: Complete!
- 1980-89: Complete!
- 1990s: 1990-94 complete and the rest of the decade is being scanned.

While Chieftains are being posted from oldest to newest, the 1950, 1959 and 1965 yearbooks "jumped the line" thanks to the support of devoted Uni alumni:


When you visit the UHEF.org *Yearbooks page*, you can click on any of the covers and browse

Uni's boys basketball team is not only undefeated, but is getting noticed. *Eric Sondheimer* of the Los Angeles Times <u>noted</u> in an online story on December 15 that "Westchester and Fairfax remain the favorites to win the Western League, but the most likely league team to be unbeaten well into January is University, which improved to 9-0 on Thursday with an 89-69 win over South East.

"Gabe Okmin scored 29 points, Jude Agbasi had 17 and Daisone Hughes had 16. The Wildcats have a chance to be 14-0 before having to face Westchester and Fairfax."

It's doubly nice that this season's Wildcats are coached by alum *Steve Ackerman* of the Class of 1989, and already have a pre-league-season win over Palisades!
