# UNI ONLINE YEARBOOK PROJECT EXPANDING; WHEN IS YOUR YEAR GOING UP?

▶ Many people are checking out the first eight Uni yearbooks that are now online at the UHEF.org Web site (click *here*), and the project is now ready to expand.

In honor of its continuous devotion to Uni and contributions to the Uni Hi Education Foundation, the first Class Yearbook Presenter is *Buddy Fischer* '50. In gratitude for his support, the 1950 yearbook will be in the next group of yearbooks to be scanned and posted for viewing on the UHEF.org site.

The yearbooks already posted are:

- 1924 (as Wilson Junior High School, on what became the Harding and Uni site!)
- 1925
- 1926
- 1927
- 1938
- 1942
- 1966
- 1967

In the next group, we'll be scanning 1928, 1929, 1930, 1931 and Fischer's 1950 Chieftain. Please note:

- Yearbooks will generally be processed from the older years forward, owing to their aging condition. Individuals or classes who wish to "jump the line" will be able to do so upon request by pre-payment of the cost of digitizing and presenting their yearbook.
- The cost for "Advanced Publication" of any specific year is a one-time payment of \$499 (an average of the costs for all yearbooks for scanning, editing, page matching, posting and server maintenance), which includes two downloads and Presenter status on the class page.

When you visit the UHEF.org <u>Yearbooks page</u>, you can click on any of the covers and browse any of the books now online. If you click the "Purchase" button below each cover, you'll be taken to another page with options for:

- (1) Buying a download (PDF) of that yearbook, for \$99, or
- (2) Buying a download (PDF) of that yearbook and adding a Dedication that will be shown on that page indefinitely, for \$149, or
- (3) Buying a download (PDF) of that yearbook and becoming a Presenter of that class yearbook, shown on the top of the page indefinitely, for \$199.

Payments are taken by credit card through PayPal, but you don't have to have a PayPal account to use it.

## **ON CAMPUS**

Congratulations to Uni senior football star *Eugene Ford*, who signed a National Letter of Intent to enroll (and play) at the University of Hawaii. Ford (6-2, 185 lbs.) played wide receiver and safety at Uni, but was recruited to be a defensive back for the Rainbow Warriors.

Ford signed his National Letter of Intent in a ceremony in the Uni gym on February 3, th first day on which commitments could be made. The NLI was then faxed (still the primary method of transmittal for college signees!) at 9:43 a.m. Ford is part of Hawaii's 18-member recruiting class for new coach *Nick Rolovich*. • Boys/Basketball 13-17 overall (2-10 Western League)

After a tough second half of the season, Uni was seeded 12th in the City's Division I playoff bracket and will travel to fifth-seed Grant on February 18 for a 7 p.m. match.

Junior point guard *Jude Agbasi* finished the regular season as Uni's leading scorer at 15.1 points per game (50.0% shooting from the field) and was second on the team at 7.4 rebounds a game. Junior guard *Gabe Okmin*, who has played only since January 1, finished at 14.8 points per game, the only other Wildcat in double figures. Junior wing *Kevin Javier* led the team with 7.6 rebounds per game.

## **UNI ALUMNI NOTEBOOK**

Unfortunately, neither Uni nor the Foundation has complete lists of former Uni students, faculty or staff. So we're putting your notice here in hopes that some of your classmates will reach out!

► Thanks to alum *David Kahan* '87 (<u>dkahan@mail.sdsu.edu</u>) for checking our list of Uni track & field records last issue and helping fill on the blanks:

"The two track athletes in question (i.e., first names unknown) are: Henry Bausley and Michael Howard."

Howard holds the Uni 400 m record at 48.97 from 1987 and Bausley has the 110 m Hurdles mark of 14.2 (hand time) from 1986. The full list is in WWR issue 32 (see it here).

The Uni records "list" was kept on a giant plaque created during the Kampmann Era and updated for years afterwards, displayed in the Uni gym on Westgate Avenue. However, when the rebuilt facility on Westgate was demolished about 2008 due to its position near an earthquake fault, the records plaque was trashed.

## **SIXTH PERIOD BELL**

We've had lots of requests for class names by decade. We previously ran the names from the 1930s through the 1970s, so with thanks to UHEF Co-President *Judy Wolfenstein*, here are the 1920s (as available) and the last class names we could find, from the 1980s:

S '25: None listed 1980: Futurians S '26: Pioneers 1981: Centurians

W '27: Not available S '27: Not available

W '28: Not available S '28: Mariners What happened after 1981?

W '29: Twenty-Niners S '29: Mandarins

The Mandarins of S '29 were the last graduating class from Harding High School, as the name was officially changed to University High School on July 1, 1929, saluting the opening of the new UCLA campus in Westwood.

Class names apparently stopped after the Class of 1981. Can anyone say why? If you graduated in 1982 or later and had a Class name, please send it to us!
