

Tickets may be purchased for all shows in advance (up to the day prior to the show) at <u>BrownPaperTickets.com</u>: \$10 for adults and \$5 for students (with identification) via credit card, or at the Uni Student Store or at the door (cash only). Online purchases carry a 99-cent fee plus a 3.5% charge for credit-card processing.

Parking is available on-campus in the Barrington Avenue or Westgate Avenue lots, not to mention the ample street parking around the Uni campus.

For those who remember *Dick Agbabian* '75, a happy-go-lucky personality who enjoyed a laugh as much as playing varsity baseball or performing in Theater Arts, the skies have been dark for some time. And getting darker. Uni Theater Arts director Sperling explained:

Uni High is pleased to dedicate all performances of this spring's Disney's "High School Musical" to a special alumnus, Dick Agbabian (Class of 1975). An honors graduate and active member of the Uni Theatre group, Dick was completing his senior year at Azusa Pacific University when he underwent a routine surgery that went tragically wrong. Since then, for the past 37 years, Dick has had to face life with severe disabilities, without the ability to talk, walk, eat without assistance, or do any of the other things that most of us take for granted. While a settlement for the malpractice enabled Dick to receive loving care from his family and a wonderful caregiver for many years, his increasing medical needs have taken a toll on Dick's finances, with devastating consequences.
