► LUNCHEON COMMEMORATING THE DEDICATION OF KAMPMANN STADIUM AND PATTON TRACK

A special luncheon will be held in the South Gym to honor legendary Uni coach **Dick Kampmann** and the late **Mel Patton** '43, the greatest athlete in Uni history, for whom the new athletic facilities have been named. "Kampmann Stadium" and "Patton Track" were dedicated at ceremonies held last October.

Coach K, now 91, and his family, the Patton family, Uni legend (and Olympic bronze medalist) *Craig Dixon* '44 and Patton biographer *Larry Booth* will be present for the luncheon, from 11:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m., in the South Gym. Doors will open at 10:30 a.m. (and not before, please).

Special plaques marking the facilities in honor of Kampmann, Patton and Uni's first principal, *Angus Cavanaugh* (for whom the football field is named), will be unveiled.

Tickets are \$60 through May 10 and \$75 from May 11-13 (password required: "SpecialK"). No

tickets will be sold at the door. Tickets may only be purchased online *at* <u>www.brownpapertickets.com/event/2533630</u>.




