COMBO REUNION FOR THE CLASSES OF 1958-1962 COMING NEXT MARCH 12

Class reunions are usually just that: reunions of one class. But not for the classes of 1958 through 1962, which will have the opportunity to come together as a group next March 12.

How did this get started? We got the story from **Yosh Kawahara** S '59 (<u>kawahar@uclabruins.com</u>) and **Howard Uller** S '59 (<u>uller@ca.rr.com</u>), and Uller provided these details:

- "The first reunion was of the 1959 varsity basketball team. This team won the Western League with an undefeated record; and, to wit, won the consolation/third place trophy in the City basketball tournament by beating Jefferson in that game. I must add that no Western League team beat Jefferson in those days.
- "The second reunion held two years later included the wives or significant others of our team.

The untimely death of our teammate **Scott Rathsom** was the stimulus for the reunions. Four of us were at his memorial service and agreed to pool our efforts to build a reunion. The hope was that we could gather as a team to celebrate our accomplishments before any other teammate died.

"We so enjoyed the first gathering that the subsequent gatherings were well received.

- "The third gathering started as another of the 1959 team reunions. But about a month before the reunion, **Jane Schwab (Mintz)** emailed asking if she could come. The team unanimously voted yes and decided to make it a Uni High sports/sports fans reunion. 95 people came to that event and it was so much fun that a two-hour session felt like 20 minutes.
- "So another reunion is set for March 2018. The steering committee behind this is **Mike**Levitt (who has endless drive and energy), **Yosh Kawahara**, Jane Schwab (Mintz),
 Sally Martin (Garcia), and myself.

"117 people have sent emails with their intent to be there. Several of them are coming from some distance. We enjoy the gathering and 'hanging' and dining with the best.

• "Final note: To a person we feel privileged and blessed to be alumni of Uni High – that school that opened our eyes to embracing diversity, giving life our best shot, etc."

UHEF SCHOLARSHIP UPDATE

- ▶ Did you know that the UHEF thanks to your donations supports these annual scholarships for Uni students:
 - *Community Service Scholarship*: \$1,000 awarded to a graduating senior who has shown exceptional dedication to community service during their tenure at Uni.
 - Jack Moskowitz Principal's Award: Named for one of Uni's most outstanding principals (1984-93), a \$1,000 award to a graduating senior selected by Uni Principal Eric Davidson for exceptional achievement and service to the school.
 - **Sharon Mednick Scholarship**: Created in 2004 from a \$10,000 bequest left by Uni counselor Sharon Mednick, this annual \$1,000 scholarship is awarded to a senior interested in a career in education.

In addition, two new scholarships are set to be inaugurated in 2017-18 with your donations:

UNI ALUMNI NOTEBOOK

Reunion information and updates for the Classes of 1957-1958-62 -1967-1968-1978-1987-1997: Check the <u>Reunions</u> section above!

▶ In our last issue (<u>here</u>), we asked about a class photo that was purportedly the Class of 1951, sent along by **Susan Moore** (<u>susanmoore2015@gmail.com</u>), the widow of the late **Dr**.

Richard Moore, a member of that class.

Looks like it isn't. *Rodgers Dorr* S '51 (*urirbd@aol.com*) is quite sure: "I was in that class and I don't know what that picture is but it's not our graduating class. The resolution was not good enough to identify specific individuals, however, the Summer of '51 graduating class was at least three times the size of the group in that picture."

Thanks to everyone who replied; maybe we'll never know who was pictured, but it was not the Uni Class of 1951!

- The massive plaques saluting Coach *Dick Kampmann*, Uni sprinter (and double Olympic gold medalist) *Mel Patton* '43 and the school's first principal, *Angus Cavanaugh*, are mounted outside the north side of the South Gym. If you would like to see them, please note that Uni is a closed school and requires visitors to register. Please arrange your entry by calling Uni (310) 914-3500 and ask to schedule a date to come to see the plaques.
- We have received a number of inquiries about how one can obtain a copy of an old diploma or a proof of graduation. We have the answers (we think):
 - If you graduated within the past 10 years, call the Registrar's Office at Uni directly, and they can help you. Uni's telephone number is (310) 914-3500.
 - If you graduated before 2006, here's the link to the LAUSD Web page which includes instructions on how to obtain your records: http://achieve.lausd.net/transcripts. Please read the requirements carefully!

SIXTH PERIOD BELL

Did you know that Uni was the first-ever Los Angeles-area school to participate in the Academic Decathlon?

It's true (details <u>here</u> – see p. 6)! The concept was originally developed by Orange County Superintendent of Schools *Robert Peterson*, with the first event held in 1968. Although a considerable local success, Peterson wanted to expand it well beyond Orange County and the next logical spot was just to the north:

"In 1978, Dr. Peterson met with **Dr. William Johnston**, Superintendent of Los Angeles Unified School District, **Harry Handler**, Deputy, and **Dr. Paul Possemato**, Assistant Superintendent for Secondary Instruction. The purpose of the meeting was to encourage LAUSD to field a team to compete in the first annual State of California academic competition. Dr. Peterson indicated that the Academic Decathlon was an Orange County success but Orange County, at the time, was predominately suburban, Anglo, and middle class. He wanted to prove its value in an urban setting. Los Angeles was the place for such a success. Dr. Johnston gave the job of fielding the school team to Dr. Possemato, stating that the best school to represent the district would be one that could provide a multi-ethnic team.

"Dr. Possemato met with University High School principal Paul Godfrey, who enthusiastically agreed to support the program. The two coaches were George Bonorris and

Barbara Golding. Dr. Possemato collected all of the magazines, books and other research materials that the team needed. University High School competed in April 1979 at Chapman College in what was now called the California Academic Decathlon (CAD). Schools from 23 counties participated in the competition, and the following year participation increased to 43 counties. (Emphasis added)"
