GET READY FOR LAUGHS AT "THE 25th ANNUAL PUTNAM COUNTY SPELLING BEE," AT UNI ON NOVEMBER 1-2-8-9

▶ "It's one of the funniest shows we've done at Uni. We are just sitting there and laughing our heads off at each rehearsal. It's just a funny show.

So says Uni's Director of Theater Arts, *Ronnie Sperling* '76 of the Fall 2017 Uni theater production of "*The 25th Annual Putnam County Spelling Bee*" that starts November 1 at the Stivelman Theater on campus.

"The interesting part is there is audience participation in it," noted Sperling. "The authors of the show not only were the authors, they were in the show too. They came from this improv group and they wanted to make that a big part of the musical.

"The show is never the same twice because of all of the improv elements in it. From one particular line, they give you 100 different variations.

"It's always going to be topical; you never know what's going to happen. The World Series, the current status of the country and the White House might crop up, what's popular on TV or in the movies might pop up.

"That's a whole new skill set that the kids are learning, the put on this production. We judge by the late-night talk shows or 'Saturday Night Live.' If they're using it, we tell the cast they can use it."

The *Spelling Bee* takes you back to school in a 2004 creation by *William Finn* that won two Tony Awards and played on Broadway for 1,136 performances.

The pressure of the competition and the wild characters such as former spelling bee champion Rona Lisa Peretti, Vice Principal Douglas Patch, "comfort counselor" Mitch Mahoney and the spellers makes for an enchanting ride to the intersection of effort and attraction.

20 ADVANCED PLACEMENT COURSES AT UNI IN 2017-18

Advanced Placement courses, which can carry college credits based on a end-of-course exam, are among the most in-demand courses at high schools throughout the country.

As in 2016-17, Uni is offering 20 AP classes for the 2017-18 term:

- AP Calculus AB
- AP Calculus BC
- AP Chemistry
- AP Computer Science A
- AP English Language and Composition
- AP English Literature and Composition
- AP Environmental Science
- AP Government
- AP Macro Economics
- AP Physics 1

- AP Psychology
- AP Seminar
- AP Spanish Language and Culture
- AP Spanish Literature and Culture
- AP Statistics
- AP Studio Art: 2-D Design
- AP Studio Art: 3-D Design
- AP Studio Art: Drawing
- AP United States History
- AP World History

The course list is the same as last year, with the exception of the addition of AP Seminar, while AP Biology was dropped. The AP Seminar course was created in 2014 as part of a two-stage curriculum with AP Research, which will be offered at Uni next year.

<u>Seminar</u> provides an introduction to conducting independent analysis of complex ideas across various disciplines. When followed by AP Research, students can earn an AP Research and Seminar Certificate. When the two courses are combined with four other AP courses, a student can earn an AP Capstone Diploma.

Western League champions!

Coach *Eric Temena's* team won the Western League 18-hole title at Balboa Municipal Golf Course (par 73) in Encino by one shot over Palisades, 517-518, and ahead of Fairfax, Venice and LACES.

Uni golfers *Kara Temena* (72: 2nd) and *Emily Kim* (97: tied for 6th) both qualified for the City Championships next week. They were followed by teammates *Akira Shelton* (106), *Yoonsuh Jung* (113) and *Ali Wilbur* (129).

Unfortunately, Uni will not advance to the City team championship, as the league winners in the 9-hole matches during the regular season (Fairfax and Palisades) were the qualifiers.

Uni won its first match of the season, a 4-3 victory over Hamilton and another 4-3 win over Fairfax to close it. Unfortunately, the Wildcats won only one match in between and finished with a 3-11 on the season and 3-9 in Western League play.
