# LEGENDARY APPEALS JUDGE STEPHEN REINHARDT '48 PASSES AT 87

• One of the nation's most noteworthy judges, *Stephen Reinhardt*, Class of 1948, died on March 29 of a heart attack. He was 87.

Ninth Circuit Chief Judge *Sidney R. Thomas* said, "We have lost a wonderful colleague and friend. As a judge, he was deeply principled, fiercely passionate about the law and fearless in his decisions."

A member of the Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals since 1980, when he was nominated by U.S. President *Jimmy Carter*, Reinhardt was known as the "liberal lion" of the Court; the <u>Above</u> the Law blog noted that:

"Whether you loved or loathed his jurisprudence, Judge Reinhardt's importance and influence cannot be denied. His unapologetic liberalism won him admirers on the left, who viewed him as a jurist of courage and principle rarely seen since the Warren Court, and critics from the right, who branded him a liberal judicial activist of the highest order. When conservatives criticized the Ninth Circuit, they were often talking about Reinhardt. ...

"Judge Reinhardt's major rulings included opinions striking down the constitutionality of the words "under God" in the Pledge of Allegiance, state laws prohibiting physician-assisted suicide, and California's ban on same-sex marriage in Proposition 8. These and many other decisions, especially rulings in the death-penalty and habeas-corpus areas, wound up getting reversed or vacated by the Supreme Court, making Reinhardt one of the most-reversed judges before SCOTUS. But he was untroubled; as he memorably quipped, 'They can't catch 'em all."

According to his obituary in the <u>Los Angeles Times</u>, "Reinhardt is survived by his wife, *Ramona Ripston*, who for decades headed the ACLU of Southern California; three adult children, *Mark Reinhardt*, 57, a professor of political science at Williams College; *Justin Reinhardt*, 52, a musician; and *Dana Reinhardt*, 47, a novelist; and seven grandchildren."



• Boys/Basketball:

Wrapping up Uni's 26-6 season were honors for several Wildcats on the All-Los Angeles City teams.

Senior guard *Daisone Hughes* was selected to the <u>All-City Basketball Team</u>, including all divisions, and was selected as the "Player of the Year" in City Division I.

In addition, soph forward *David Cheatom* and senior guard *Richard Wilson Jr.* were selected to the All-Division I team.

All three were selected to the Western League first team. Senior guard *Rashon Crutcher* was named to the second team and junior guard *Nicolas Smith* and senior center *Kingsley Onwudiwe* received honorable mentions.

One more tribute to Uni: *Eric Sondheimer* of the *Los Angeles Times* noted in a <u>tweet</u> that "L.A. University beat two State champions this season – View Park and Crossroads. Can the Wildcats get a do-over?" Uni was eliminated in the quarterfinals of the State Division III tournament, but defeated View Park (State Division IV winners), 67-62, in the City Division I playoffs and Crossroads (State Division II winners) in a non-conference game on January 9.

• Boys/Baseball:

These are tough times for the Uni baseball program. Despite the massive upgrades to the school's athletic facilities in recent years, the renovation of what is now Kampmann

Stadium eliminated the Uni baseball field and all Wildcat games are played on the road.

Thus far, Uni is 0-5 on the season and will begin the Western League season at Pali on April 3. See Uni's scores and statistics on *MaxPreps.com here*.

#### • Boys/Golf:

Coach *Eric Temena's* squad is 2-1, with wins over Carson (252-273) and Venice (256-DNF), and a close, 249-262 loss to L.A. CES on March 19. *Lawrence Kim* (+6 vs. Carson), *Anuv Gupta* (+12 vs. Venice) and Gupta and *Vishal Vinodh* (+12 vs. LACES) were Uni's low scorers.

#### • Boys/Swimming:

#### • Boys/Volleyball:

## **UHEF SCHOLARSHIP UPDATE**

▶ Did you know that the UHEF – thanks to your donations – supports these annual scholarships for Uni students:

- *Community Service Scholarship*: \$1,000 awarded to a graduating senior who has shown exceptional dedication to community service during their tenure at Uni.
- Jack Moskowitz Principal's Award: Named for one of Uni's most outstanding principals (1984-93), a \$1,000 award to a graduating senior selected by Uni Principal Eric Davidson for exceptional achievement and service to the school.

"Loy is correct on the field graduation, What did become the Vagabond class of Summer '58, was made up of the 9th grade Emerson Jr High graduating class. We (Emerson) were so large, we were the ones who graduated from Royce Hall [UCLA]. Grad night was a terrific show and I think Joey Bishop was the only one of the "Pack" missing. My Uni birthline goes back to my parents, who graduated in summer '34!

## **SIXTH PERIOD BELL**

▶ The shared-use concept that eventually placed the new Collins & Katz Family YMCA on a corner of the Uni campus was saluted as a paradigm for future uses of the L.A. Unified School District's vast real estate holdings.

The L.A. Unified Advisory Task Force recommended that a team of real estate experts be engaged to review the District's properties and examine the possibilities for improvements and revenue.

A review of the report in the <u>Los Angeles Times</u> noted that:

The task force's report gave some examples of underused properties, including 16 acres in a downtown industrial area and two spots in the west San Fernando Valley.

It also mentions successes, including the new YMCA adjacent to University High School in Sawtelle, on what used to be an empty lot. The 60,000-square-foot building serves students as well as area residents.

Such projects should happen elsewhere, said [co-chair Austin] Beutner, who added that the Sawtelle project took too long — 12 years — to complete.

Since when does *The Times* refer to West Los Angeles by its ancient name of Sawtelle? And

the lot on which the YMCA now stands wasn't empty, but had unused bungalows on it. Oh well, as **P.T. Barnum** thought and was <u>reputed</u> to have said, "The only bad publicity is no publicity."
