## WHAT'S COMING NEXT FOR UNI'S THEATRE PROGRAM?

Following up on the enormous success of Grease! at Uni, Director of Theatre Arts *Ronnie Sperling* '76 wasted no time in announcing next year's schedule:

"We are proud to announce the shows for the 2018/19 Uni Theatre Season!

"Fall 2018 will bring, for the first time to the Uni stage,'Schoolhouse Rock Live,' based on the classic ABC TV show. This will not only play at Stivelman but is a 'Theatre for Young Audiences' show and local feeding schools will see it.

"Spring 2019: we are excited to produce 'Disney's The Lion King." Get your tickets early!"

Sperling also had good news on other fronts:

- Through a United Talent Agency grant, Uni was able to upgrade its costume and scene shops, both crucial behind-the-scenes parts of the production program.
- Uni's unique Guest Artist Week is bringing several professionals to Stivelman Theater to work with the Theatre Arts troupe, including:
  - Joe Malone, the choreographer for Michael Jackson's iconic <u>Beat It video</u> from 1982.
     Malone and Uni choreographer Lindsey Lorenz taught part of the Beat It program.
  - *Michelle Elkins*, choreographer for *Sutton Foster* on Broadway and "*Disney's Hunchback of Notre Dame*."
  - o *Miranda Riddle*, makeup artist extraordinaire.
  - o Stefan Haves, Cirque du Soliel's clown teacher.
  - Albee Selznick, actor, magician and Uni alumnus!
- Uni's *Akira Shelton* was nominated for Leading Female for the Jerry Herman Awards, the top award for high school theater in California.

Shelton was nominated for her performance as Logainne Swartzandgrubenierre in "*The 25th Annual Putnam County Spelling Bee*" and will continue on with the awards evaluation through auditions on May 30-31 at the Ricardo Montalban Theater in Hollywood. The Jerry Herman Awards are on Sunday, June 3, also at The Ricardo Montalban Theater.

Uni may be nominated in other categories, but those will be announced later.

## KEEP 'EM COMING: 564 BOOKS DONATED TO THE UNI LIBRARY!

The amazing donations to the Uni library continue without end, as some 564 new books have now been provided to the library by generous alumni and friends since the program began in December 2016.

Uni librarian **Tascha Folsoi** '86 – and a donor herself – says of the latest donations, "We were able to add to our outdated poetry section with poets relevant to today's students. In addition, these donations add books on filmmaking to support our students in digital media classes.

"Also included in the donations were books written by and about people with autism, who, according to recent statistics cited in a CBS online article, are now being born at a rate of 1 in 47. Building a collection that is inclusive and addresses the experiences of the segment of our society is very important. I appreciate all the donations that help us reflect the interests and realities of our many students.

"We also received a grant from United Talent Agency, which enabled us to update areas of our collection like the geography section, which had decades-old books on countries, some of which have long since changed names and borders. They also supported our book club by purchasing multiple copies of books for next year's reads."

These gifts have been made by a total of 41 donors who have self-identified and many more who wish to remain anonymous. Special thanks to *Ruth Roberts*, who has personally donated more than 200 books! We now have donors from the 1940s, '50s, '60s, '70s and '80s, and even one from a future graduate! • Boys/Baseball:

These are tough times for the Uni baseball program, but the Wildcats won their final regular-season game, 8-2, vs. Fairfax, to finish 1-17 and 1-11 in the Western League.

The massive upgrades to the school's athletic facilities, especially the renovation of what is now Kampmann Stadium eliminated the Uni baseball field and all Wildcat games are played on the road.

#### **★** Western League Champions **★**

Coach *Eric Temena's* squad finished 6-1 in its dual-meet season and won the Western League title on April 30, posting a score of 492, with three finishers in the top 10:

- 10. Dylan Elliot, 100

Playing 18 holes at the par-72 Wilson Golf Course in Griffith Park, Uni outscored Carson

(494) and RFK (625); L.A. CES, Venice and Fairfax had incomplete teams. *Brian Kang* of RFK was the individual winner and the only one to shoot under par at 71.

The City Finals will be on May 16 at the Wilson course.

#### • Boys/Swimming:

Uni ended the dual-meet season with a 2-3 record, and 1-3 in the Western League. Uni defeated Hamilton, 84-12, lost a close one to Venice (86-78) and lost to Palisades (144-26) and L.A. CES (115-50).

#### • Boys/Volleyball:

Uni tied for second in the Western League at 9-3, behind Palisades (12-0) and with the same record as Venice (9-3). *Memo Alvarado's* Wildcats was seeded second in the City's Division II playoffs and won its opener against South East, 3-1 but lost to Jordan in the quarterfinals, three sets to two (25-19, 19-25, 25-23, 21-25, 13-15) to end the season at 22-10. #### • Girls/Softball:

The Wildcats finished the regular season at 7-13 and 2-10 in the Western League. Uni was seeded eighth in the City's Division III playoffs and defeated Marquez, 13-5 in the first round on May 10, but lost to Fairfax, 6-5, in the quarterfinals on May 14 to finish 8-14.

#### **UHEF SCHOLARSHIP UPDATE**

- ▶ Did you know that the UHEF thanks to your donations supports these annual scholarships for Uni students:
  - *Community Service Scholarship*: \$1,000 awarded to a graduating senior who has shown exceptional dedication to community service during their tenure at Uni.
  - Jack Moskowitz Principal's Award: Named for one of Uni's most outstanding principals (1984-93), a \$1,000 award to a graduating senior selected by Uni Principal Eric Davidson for exceptional achievement and service to the school.
  - Sharon Mednick Scholarship: Created in 2004 from a \$10,000 bequest left by Uni counselor Sharon Mednick, this annual \$1,000 scholarship is awarded to a senior interested in a career in education.

Uni alum and U.S. Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals judge *Carlos Bea* '52 wrote in to note the memorial services for *Stephen Reinhardt* '48, who passed away on March 29:

"Judge Stephen Reinhardt of the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit, died recently and was remembered at a Memorial Ceremony April 29 at the Westwood Village Theatre, to a crowd of his family, former clerks, judges, attorneys and government leaders, among them Supreme Court Justice Sonia Sotomayor, Governor Jerry Brown, and Mayor [Eric] Garcetti."

### **SIXTH PERIOD BELL**

Uni's petition to become an <u>Affiliated Charter School</u> is moving along, and quickly. Principal *Eric Davidson* recently wrote to the UHEF, noting:

"The Charter petition has been submitted to the District's Charter School Office for review. The plan will be presented to the LAUSD Board of Education on June 5, 2018. We anticipate the plan being approved."

When approved, Uni's name will change slightly to reflect its Affiliated Charter status; many of you voted on possible name changes earlier this year on the Uni Web site. Once settled, it

will be the fourth name for the campus at Ohio and Texas:

• Fall 1923: Wilson Junior High School

• Fall 1924: Warren G. Harding High School

• Fall 1929: University High School

• Fall 2018: ???

As there are many "University High Schools" in the U.S., Uni has been known for some time within the Los Angeles Unified School District as "University Senior High." What will the new name be?
